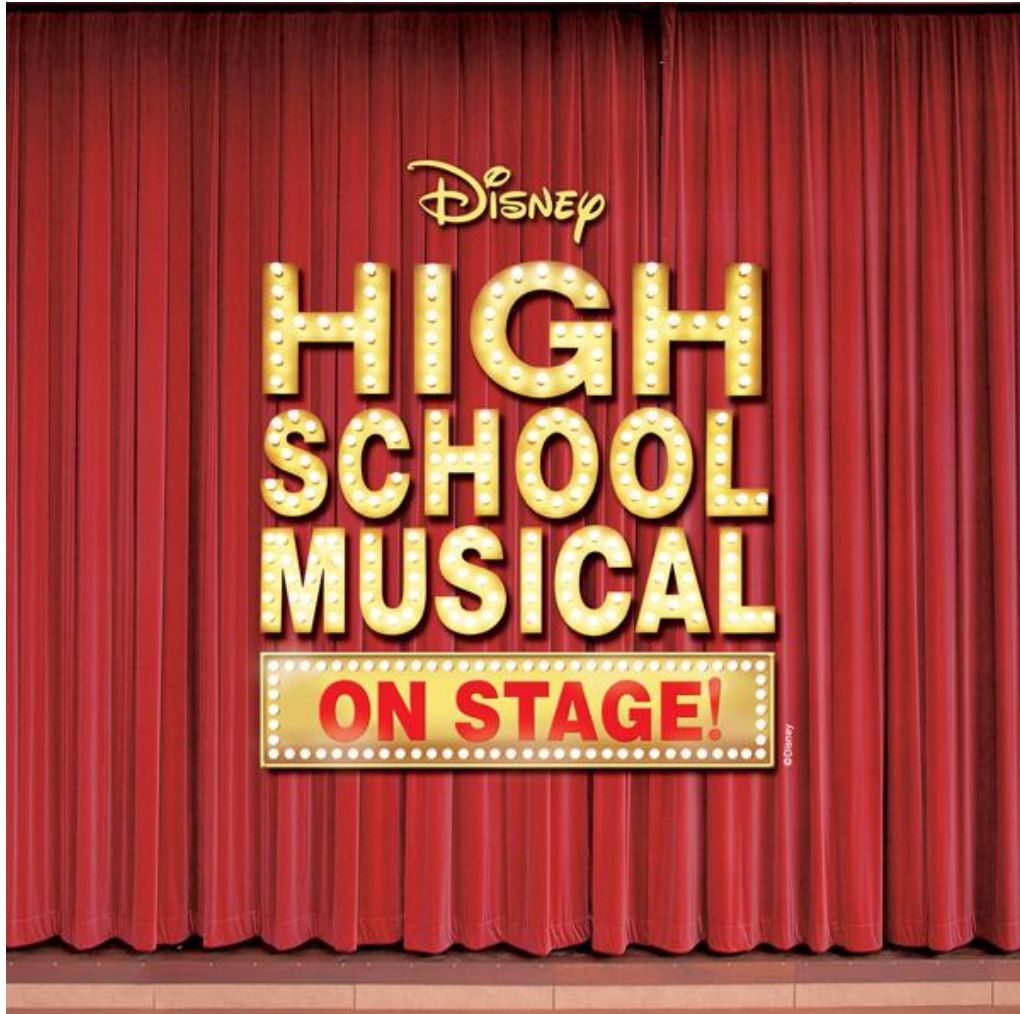

THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR TAKING TIME TO ATTEND TODAY'S PERFORMANCE. THE STUDENTS AND STAFF HAVE WORKED TIRELESSLY ON STAGE AND BEHIND THE SCENES TO PUT TOGETHER THIS PRODUCTION, AND IT ALWAYS AMAZES ME HOW MUCH CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED IN A FEW SHORT WEEKS.

THE HIGH SCHOOL SPA PROGRAM IS JUST ONE FACET OF A PROGRAM THAT HAS OVER 950 STUDENTS ENROLLED THIS SUMMER. WE'VE ALREADY HAD SHOW AND TELL PERFORMANCES AT OUR PRE-K (AT RED RIVER) AND ELEMENTARY PROGRAMS (AT DISCOVERY, PHOENIX, AND SHARON LUTHERAN CHURCH), AND OUR MIDDLE SCHOOL PROGRAM CONCLUDED AT THE END OF JUNE IN A FANTASTIC PERFORMANCE THAT FILLED THE SOUTH MIDDLE SCHOOL CAFETORIUM. JULY BRINGS US A FINAL ELEMENTARY SPA SESSION AT RED RIVER, AND THE MYSPA PROGRAM GETS STARTED AS WELL WITH A PERFORMANCE AT CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL THAT WILL CLOSE OUT OUR 35TH SEASON AT THE END OF JULY. YOU WILL SEE A GLIMPSE OF MANY OF THESE FINE ARTS ACTIVITIES AT THE CONCLUSION OF THIS PERFORMANCE IN OUR "BODY ELECTRIC" SLIDESHOW.

FOLLOWING TONIGHT'S CURTAIN CALL, THERE WILL BE A FINAL MUSICAL NUMBER. THE REST OF THE STUDENTS IN THE SUMMER PERFORMING ARTS COMPANY WILL JOIN THE CAST TO PERFORM "I SING THE BODY ELECTRIC." THIS SONG HAS CLOSED ALL SPA PERFORMANCES FOR THE PAST 34 YEARS. THIS SYMBOLIC SONG TIES THE ENTIRE PROGRAM TOGETHER. 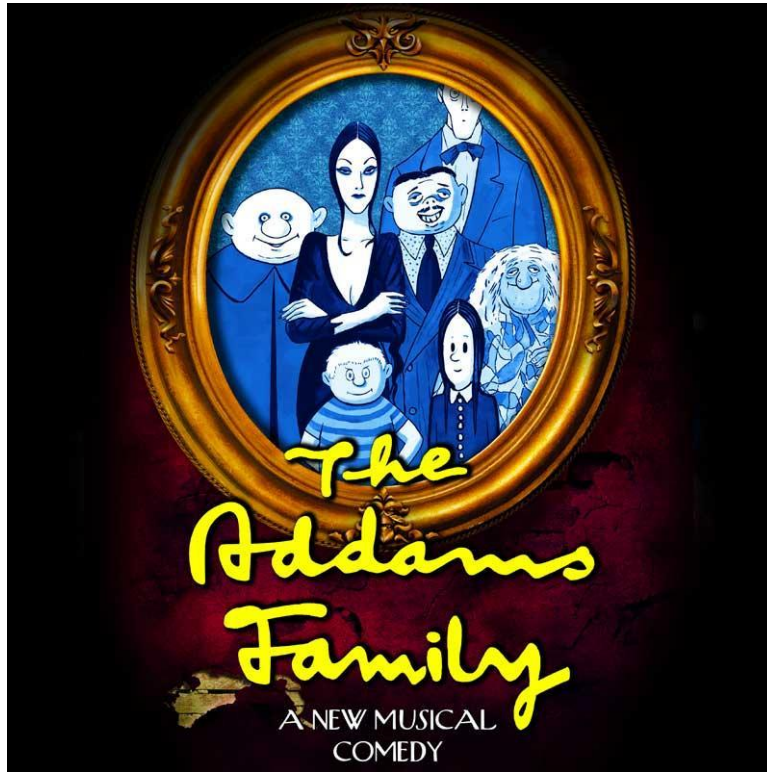
