

## DIRECTOR'S NOTES

The Wiz is an adaptation of L. Frank Baum's The Wizard of Oz. It was written by William F. Brown and composed by Charlie Smalls. It opened on Broadway at the Majestic Theatre on January 5, 1975.

The Wiz was an all-black version of an all-white story. The setting for the story is the same. It starts and ends in Kansas, but most of the plot evolves in the land of Oz. The script is 70s black urban slang—at least that is what it sounded like to our predominantly white North Dakotan ears. Somehow to leave the script as it was seemed like the wrong thing to do. We have taken the liberty of dropping the dialect and adapting the story again. Now we have a white version of a black version of a white story! Of course it works, because the Wizard of Oz is not only timeless, but it is not bound by culture or race.

If you love the Wizard of Oz, you will notice there are some slight differences. The character of the Wizard is perhaps the biggest difference. He is not so much an illusion as a person who has lost himself to the desire for the simple things in life...power, prestige, and money.

The music is also quite different. We have found it to be refreshingly so. It has been fun to work with a script and with music that we haven't seen very often and have never done before. We hope that it is refreshing to our audiences as well. You know the story, you don't know the music, and you don't know the style. We hope that you will find it to be delightful!
