DIRECTOR’S NOTES

*Once On This Island* is a musical adaptation of Rosa Guy’s novel *My Love, My Love*. Rosa Guy’s novel is an adaptation of *The Little Mermaid* by Hans Christian Anderson. Guy sets her story on the Island of Haiti, where the two different worlds are not the ocean and the land, but the black poor and the French Aristocrats. These two worlds might as well be land and sea, as they are as different. Guy’s novel is dark. The girl does not end up with the rich prince. After all, in real life this would not happen. The fairy tale aspect of the story is inside her head. Lynn Ahrens and Stephen Flaherty put another twist into the story. They created a story within a story. The story of TiMoune becomes a story of forgiveness, grace and love that must be handed down to our children and our children’s children.

“*Once on this Island* is based on the cultural, religious, and racial divisions found in Haiti between the mulatto ruling class and the dark skinned, rural peasants. Our original production in New York was strictly cast along racial lines; however, since the story transcends the issue of race, we have supplied specific text alterations to allow greater flexibility in making casting choices while still maintaining the core ideas of prejudice and separation of people because of their differences,” say the creators of the show. As our cast is predominantly white, the social caste system of extreme poverty and extreme wealth are the two different worlds.

That being said, the girl will not end up with the boy. The girl will make a bargain with Papa Ge, the god of death. In the beginning of the story, the boy is hurt in a car accident. She makes a deal. She trades his life for her own. At the end of the story, after she has been cast out of the grand hotel and is left on the street, death revisits and once again asks for his life. She holds to her original bargain and gives her life so that death will spare him.

Ahrens and Flaherty crafted *Once on This Island* as a story within a story. The villagers are telling the story to a little girl. They pass it on. It is a story of forgiveness and grace. It is a story to tell children. The child hearing the story says the story of TiMoune is like a tree. It is a tree that protects them from the storms and shields them from the sun. A tree is a symbol of life, which continues. Forgiveness and grace, after all, are eternal.

NOTES FROM THE SPA ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR

Each year the SPA program selects a theme for our character education part of the program. (This summer our theme is "Building Communities.") We have many community partners each summer that support our program, both companies and individuals. Every summer we plan a community service project; this summer we had a food drive. Also, each summer we look to build community relationships between other performing programs with exchange nights or trips to performances. All of this is part of "Building Communities."

However, the most important part of "Building Communities" is the community of students that the SPA program brings together. There are many performing groups within the SPA program that allow a student to "specialize" in one area. We have a group for Elementary, Middle School, and High School SPA. There are also classes such as dance or drama offered as part of the SPA Academy.
