

Director's Notes:

I look at a Musical Revue as a chance to expose kids to some unknown Musical Theatre material, and as a chance to educate them about a given composer or period. This summer I chose Frank Loesser because of *Guys and Dolls*. *Guys and Dolls* is very familiar material to most of us. Frank Loesser has given us a great deal more that we may not remember quite so easily. Frank Loesser started his career in Hollywood. He wrote numerous songs for films during the thirties and forties. He wrote *Where's Charley?* in 1948. It was his first Broadway score. Musical Theatre is a uniquely American art form. We need to educate ourselves about its history in order to appreciate its development. Frank Loesser's music gives us a perfect opportunity to experience some of the flavor of the 40's, 50's and the early 60's.

I have chosen to include *South Pacific*, as it originally ran on Broadway at the same time as *Guys and Dolls*. We have a sense of time and place in order to compare the two. I added two songs from *Sunset Boulevard* by Andrew Lloyd Webber to give us a taste of popular theatre music of the 1990's.

The cast of Frank Loesser and More hopes to help you enter the world of this intriguing man, and enjoy his music maybe for the first time, or perhaps as a fond memory.
